

- **NEVER** shoot at hard surfaces, water or anything else that may cause a ricochet.
- This airsoft gun may only be used where your local laws permit or at shooting ranges allowed by the law, and only if the ammunition does not travel further than the shooting area. Keep in mind the maximum range of the ammunition. **ALWAYS** abide by laws and regulations that apply to airsoft guns.
- **ALWAYS** check to see if the airsoft gun is **ON "SAFE"** and unloaded when getting it from another person or from storage.
- **ALWAYS** keep your finger off the trigger and away from the trigger guard until ready to shoot.
- You and others with you should **ALWAYS** wear safety shooting glasses to protect your eyes.
- If your reading or prescription glasses are not certified safety glasses, make sure you wear shooting glasses over your regular glasses.
- **NEVER** load your airsoft gun until you're ready to shoot and it's safe to do so.
- **ALWAYS** use the correct caliber ammunition that is suitable for the airsoft gun. Use **ONLY** ammunition designed for this airsoft gun.
- **NEVER** reuse ammunition.
- **ALWAYS** store the airsoft gun with the safety **ON "SAFE"**, unloaded, uncocked, separated from the ammunition, out of the reach of children, and in a secure location to prevent unauthorized people from accessing it.
- **DO NOT** attempt to disassemble or tamper with the airsoft gun.
- **ALWAYS** store this airsoft gun in a safe location.
- **ALWAYS** store ammunition separately from the gun.
- **ALWAYS** unload the airsoft gun before giving it to someone else.
- **ALWAYS** read and follow the manufacturer's manual and instructions.
- **NEVER** let a person who has not completely read this manual use this product.

**Perform routine inspection and maintenance, including:**

1. Modification of the gun mechanism may cause a gun to malfunction and tampering with a gun may make it unsafe to use.

3. Check any gun that has been dropped to ensure that its function has not been affected.

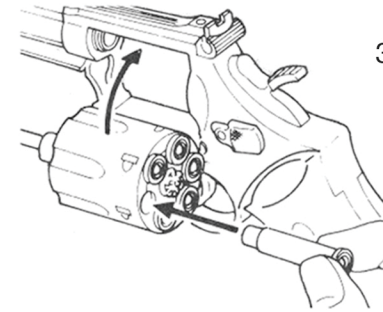
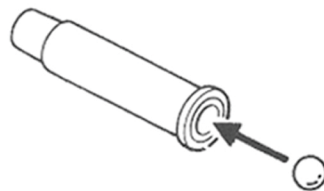


## Instructions



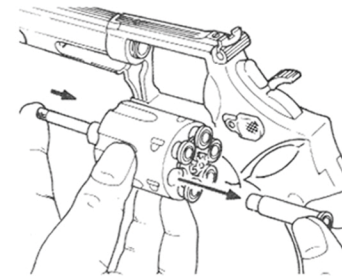
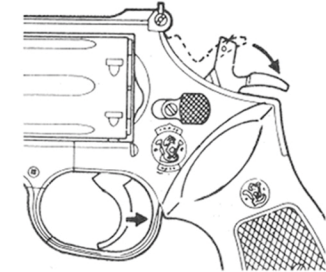
1. Push the latch forward, then turn out the cylinder, as shown.

2. Load the BB into the back of the shells until the BB is flush. Insert only 1 BB per shell.



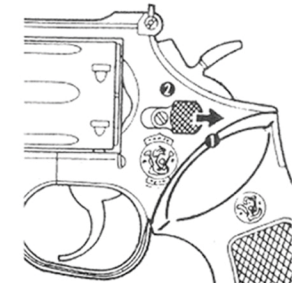
3. After loading all 6 shells, return to cylinder and close cylinder until it locks back into position.

4. Cock the hammer until locked. Gun is now ready to fire. Pull trigger to fire.



5. After exhausting the 6 rounds, pull out the cylinder and use the extractor rod to remove the shells.

**SAFETY:** When the safety latch is pushed back, the safety is engaged and the hammer cannot be cocked.  
**IMPORTANT:** Do not force cock the hammer when the safety is engaged as this may cause damage to your gun.



## Rules of Safe Shooting

- **NEVER** point the airsoft gun at any person.
- **NEVER** point the airsoft gun at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- **ALWAYS** treat the airsoft gun as if it was loaded and handle it with the same respect you would a firearm.
- **ALWAYS** aim in a **SAFE DIRECTION**. **ALWAYS** keep the muzzle pointed in a **SAFE DIRECTION**.
- **NEVER** put any part of your hand over the muzzle.
- **ALWAYS** keep the airsoft gun on "**SAFE**" until you are ready to shoot in a **SAFE DIRECTION**.
- Check behind and beyond your target to be certain you have a safe backstop and that no person or property can be endangered.
- Place the backstop in a location that will be safe should the backstop fail.
- Replace the backstop if it becomes worn.
- **ALWAYS** be sure of your target and what lies beyond it in case you miss.
